Friday's forum will be held in the new [U.S. Capitol Visitor Center](#), located on the grounds in front of the U.S. Capitol directly across the street from the U.S. Supreme Court. Entrance to the building is on First Street, NE, lower level.

Upon clearing the security check point, proceed down one level to the "Senate Information Desk, located behind the elevator bank nearest the Information Desk. You will need to present yourself at this desk, state that you are attending the sponsored event in **SVC 201/200**. You will be asked to present identification to receive a badge. **Make sure that you bring with you an official government ID, such as a valid driver's license or other form of ID with a picture on it.**

AYPF has provided a list of registered attendees to the guards. Unfortunately, for both security reasons and because the event is oversubscribed, we will not be able to accommodate participants who have not registered in advance. If you are receiving a copy of this confirmation, you are registered and on the registration list.

As parking is limited near the Capitol, we encourage you to travel via Metro, use the Red line, exit at Union Station, and walk toward the U.S. Capitol on First Street, NE. Using the Blue/Orange line, exit Capitol South, and walk towards the Capitol on First Street, SE.
