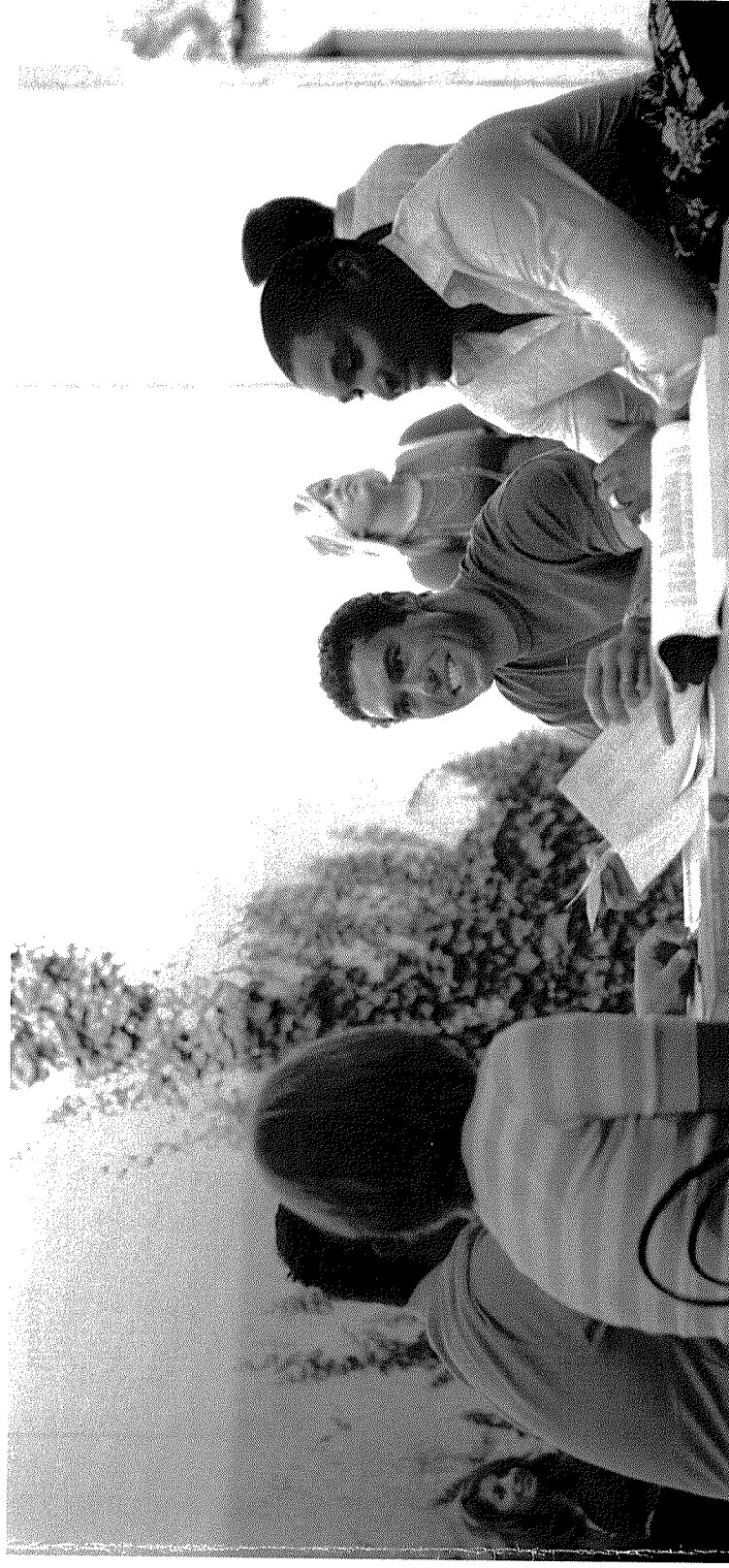

Dual Enrollment (Double-tp)	Ivy Tech Community College will actively pursue agreements to enable credentialed high school teachers to teach college courses at the high school location. When an agreement is formed, teachers who are credentialed by Ivy Tech will teach the Ivy Tech course by following the Ivy Tech syllabus and performance expectations required of all Ivy Tech Community College courses and participate in in-service training offered throughout the year. Dual enrollment registration guidelines would apply and all students participating in these programs must complete the college placement test or provide documentation of meeting pre-requisites via PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores for entry. There is no cost to the school for this program.	Students who meet course placement requirements	Courses taught by high school faculty	High school based No cost to student
Early Admission (Double-tp)	Students who seek to take college classes while in high school may enroll in Ivy Tech Community College classes by applying through the early admission program. The student will apply to the college and complete the placement test to determine eligibility for courses. After acceptance and placement the student may enroll in the Ivy Tech class of choice. The cost of tuition, books and fees is covered by entities other than the college. Professor on Loan	To support dual enrollment opportunities in the high schools, Ivy Tech Community College may provide a "professor on loan" to the high school. This mechanism involves the high school contracting with Ivy Tech to send a credentialed college instructor to teach college classes at the high school site. The class will follow a normal college meeting schedule (with high school breaks taken into consideration) and the high school can award high school credit to the student completing the class. Dual enrollment registration guidelines would apply and all students participating in these programs must complete the college placement test or provide documentation of pre-requisites via PSAT, SAT, or ACT scores for entry. The only cost for the program is reimbursement of the faculty cost at a current flat rate of \$2000 per course. Courses are limited to professor availability. Students are not charged tuition by the college to attend these classes. Ivy Tech textbooks and materials must be purchased by the student for each Professor on Loan course. Summer College Academy	To encourage continued college attendance for dual enrollment students taking classes at the high school, Ivy Tech Community College offers an annual Summer College Academy. During the summer semester, the College will provide three credits of tuition from a list of transferable general education classes or a selection of approved program specific courses free of charge up to 100 selected recipients. Additional students may choose to attend at their own expense. The Summer College Academy is open to high school students who have completed dual enrollment classes from their high school. Students are financially responsible for required textbooks and materials. College Readiness Center	The College Readiness Center is a program jointly sponsored by a local high school and Ivy Tech Community College designed to help students become academically ready for college. This self-paced academic program is available at no cost to 11th and 12th grade students. The College Readiness Center is teacher-guided, online learning with a focus on math, reading and writing. The program's goal is to prepare students for admission to college without remediation courses as a requirement for their entrance.	11th and 12th grade students attending high school	Courses are taught by Ivy Tech faculty	No cost to the student
College Placement Test	Students in the second semester of their junior year of high school may take a placement test at no cost to demonstrate college readiness. Should the student score into college-level courses, they should be encouraged to take dual enrollment or early college classes to get an advanced start on higher education. If the student does not place into college-level courses, they will be directed to a College Readiness Center or other remedial program that helps them become academically ready for college. Fast Track	The Fast-Track program is sponsored by the State of Indiana and is designed to work with students who have or are considering dropping out of high school. The program is available to students 19 and older who are out of high school or those 17 and older who attend both high school and Ivy Tech Community College with the consent of their home school.
