AYPF Shipping & Handling Charges

Besides the cost of each publication, shipping & handling fees apply as follows:

Handling Fees:

10 or less publications: \$3.00
 11 or more publications: \$7.00

USPS Shipping Fees:

1 publication: \$2.40
 2 – 3 publications: \$6.50
(UPS Ground)
 3 – 9 publications: \$15.35
 10 – 24 publications: \$34.00
 25 publications: \$41.00

Bulk orders over 25 will be discounted. Shipping charges will be applied as indicated by current UPS ground rates.

Additionally, if the buyer wants the publications shipped faster than UPS Ground (3-5 business days) we will accommodate, and the UPS rate will be determined.
