ComSTAT Meetings Overview

- Monthly, Cabinet members and Regional Superintendents look at school data
 - Data will be 'scrubbed' prior to meeting to identify which school's and data points will be analyzed and shared
 - Ground Rules – use observable data, draw hypothesis, point to solution
- Group analyzes data on school level
- Regional Superintendents provide additional qualitative data
- ComSTAT members explore all potential interventions and prioritizes top choices to align and coordinate District and Regional Centers efforts and resources
- Update status is provided at following month's meeting

School Data Analyzed

- Demographics
- Achievement
 - FCAT from 2005-06
 - Interim Assessments
- Student
 - Attendance – by grade
 - Suspension – by number of incidents
 - Achievement
 - Withdrawals from school
 - Tardies
 - Drop out rates
- Staff
 - Attendance – instructional and administrative
 - Vacancies
 - Out-of-field teachers
 - Administrative Team
- Engagement – Parent, Community Involvement
 - Regional Superintendents will provide evidence of parent/community involvement

Data Analysis

- Regional Superintendents will present schools with the following 'red-flags:'
 - Highest suspension rates
 - Highest number of absences
 - Lowest attendance overall
 - Additional area of concern if needed
- Regional Superintendents will provide qualitative data on interventions to address 'red-flag'

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
